SUBJECT: SSDI Moved To Exclusive Income Category

Please be advised that effective June 1, 2004, Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) payments are to be considered *exclusive* income when household income is used to determine an applicant's low-income status for enrollment into the Adult and Youth programs. SSDI is also considered as exclusive income for purposes of determining Adults (and Dislocated Workers when appropriate) do not exceed self-sufficiency guidelines to receive Intensive Services.

The Eligibility Technical Assistance Guide (TAG) has been updated accordingly and can be viewed in the WIA Management Information System. The Region III Eligibility TAG will be updated in the near future.
