

## Status of Department Legislation

Bill Number	Content	Status
HB79	Extends the Workforce Development Training Fund through 2017	Signed by Governor 3/15
HB80	Gives corporate officers the option of unemployment insurance coverage; requires business to be legally dissolved before benefits are paid	Signed by Governor 3/16
HB108	Authorizes issuance of bonds to repay the \$202 million federal loan for unemployment benefit payments; increases the trust fund solvency factor from 0.8 to 1.5	Awaiting Action by the Governor
HB109	Continues Idaho's eligibility for extended federal unemployment benefits through 2011	Awaiting Action by the Governor
HB122	Revises the benefit duration table to shift benefits away from workers with volatile base-period earnings to workers with stable base-period earnings	Awaiting Action by the Governor
HB154	Imposes a civil penalty of \$100 per client up to \$5,000 per quarter on professional employer organizations that fail to comply with requirements to report each client individually every quarter	Awaiting Action by the Governor
