This week, 280 more people received regular UI benefits than last week, bringing the weekly total to 20,533. Compared to last year, 5,764 more people obtained regular UI compensation. This is 39.0% more than in 2008. Upward movement in the number of unemployed obtaining regular UI is due to seasonality. This movement is likely to continue until the eighth or ninth week in 2010.



Compared to last year, \$1.3 Million more was spent for regular UI compensation, a 35.1% increase. The average weekly benefit payment for this week is \$247.92, a \$1.08 decrease from last week.


Benefits Paid for Week Ending 11/7/2009 Regular Only


Benefits Paid for Week Ending 11/7/2009 Regular + Extended





Weeks Compensated for Week Ending 11/7/2009 Regular Only




Weeks Compensated for Week Ending 11/7/2009 Regular + Extended

Forty-Fifth Week of Each Year 2000- 2009





Since triggering onto the Federal State Extended (FSE) Program in February 2009, Idaho's unemployed workers have received over \$9,000,000 in FSE funds and have claimed nearly 35,000 weeks of emergency unemployment activity. 119 people exhausted their FSE benefits this week, bringing the total number of exhaustions to 2,304.
