SUBJECT: PY 2011 WIA Allocations - REVISED

The U.S. Department of Labor recently revised states' allotment levels for the WIA Adult and Dislocated Worker for Program Year 2011. The state's allocations and each local area's share for Adult and Dislocated Worker programs are provided below-Youth remained unchanged. Allocation formulas for local areas remained the same. The change is due to the FY 2012 Continuing Appropriations Act which includes a 1.503% reduction in WIA funding to states. The Act also reduces the states' Governors' Reserve funding from 15 percent to 5 percent for all WIA programs for the entire year and increases the local area share to 95% of adult and youth funds and 70% of dislocated worker funding.

As a result of these changes, Adult program allocations have increased approximately 9 percent while Dislocated Worker allocations increased almost 12 percent from the original May 2011 allocations.
